<ul> <li>All Data, which is or will be</li> <li>Provided by BMW</li> <li>Created / collected / processed for BMW</li> <li>Stored on BMW Data carriers</li> <li>Obtained by the contractor resulting from a breach of contract</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>BMW has a legitimate interest of these data.</li> <li>These data requires a special level of protection.</li> </ul>
Not restricted as to content and time (within legal framework)	Determination of the BMWs general position
<ul> <li>Usage within scope of service provision (also between sub-contractors)</li> <li>Disclosure only if it is absolutely necessary (f.e. courts / authorities / auditors/)</li> </ul>	Covers all mandatory utilizations / transfers of the contractor.

<ul> <li>Transfer of Data beyond service provision</li> <li>Unauthorized use of BMW Data</li> <li>Before destruction of BMW Data</li> </ul>	Protection of BMW, employees, partners and customers
<ul> <li>Contractor has to transfer BMW Data to BMW if requested</li> </ul>	Entitled control requirements by BMW
<ul> <li>Contractor has to destroy all BMW Data after the end of service provision.</li> </ul>

16.3, 16.4 No safety gaps during the Service Provision	<ul> <li>No malware</li> <li>No dangerous functions (f.e. undesirable initiation / rejection / alteration of Data)</li> </ul>	Ensuring <b>confidentiality</b> , <b>availability</b> and <b>data</b> <b>integrity.</b>
16.7 Transfer of obligations within the supply chain	Subcontractor shall also be obligated by the contractor.	Ensuring information security within the supply chain
