WebEDI Application – SupplyOn Finances. Factsheet.

Brief description.

SupplyOn Finances is a WebEDI application which, from the Partner Portal of the BMW Group, enables access to payment transactions of the BMW Group at the SupplyOn marketplace. Separate registration at SupplyOn is generally not required for this.

Possible applications.

The WebEDI application, which is provided at the SupplyOn marketplace, replaces the current internal WebEDI application and the posting of papers respectively. Now users can access, print out or download following data directly from SupplyOn using the WebEDI application: Self billing invoice, revaluation of accounting system, settlement advice and remittance advice.

Access via the Partner Portal using 'SupplyOn Finance' is another possibility for users at partner companies – aside from direct access via the SupplyOn marketplace.

Requirements.

External partner users, as well as BMW Group employees require authorisation to access the Partner Portal of the BMW Group. They also require authorisation for the SupplyOn Finances application.

All external users have to be registered at the SupplyOn marketplace.

The marketplace application requires Microsoft® Internet Explorer version 5.5 or higher; version 6.0 (Service pack 1) or higher is recommended.

Registration.

Users at partner companies:
Authorisation for the application SupplyOn Finances is applied for through the Master/Administrator of the partner company concerned. Contact details for the Master/Administrator in the Partner Portal (after logging in) are available in the 'Personalise' menu.

Marketplace authorisation is set up by the SupplyOn Company Administrator of the partner company at:

Employees of the BMW Group:
Internal employees receive authorisation for the use of the application SupplyOn Finances from the Application Officer (see below).

Access.

Users at partner companies:
WebEDI is accessed via the Partner Portal without logging in to SupplyOn a second time (single sign-on). The exception is that the first time SupplyOn is accessed from the Partner Portal, you will be asked to register with SupplyOn (user ID and password).

BMW employees:
WebEDI is accessed the same way by internal employees, except, unlike external users, they do not require SupplyOn registration when first accessing the application.
